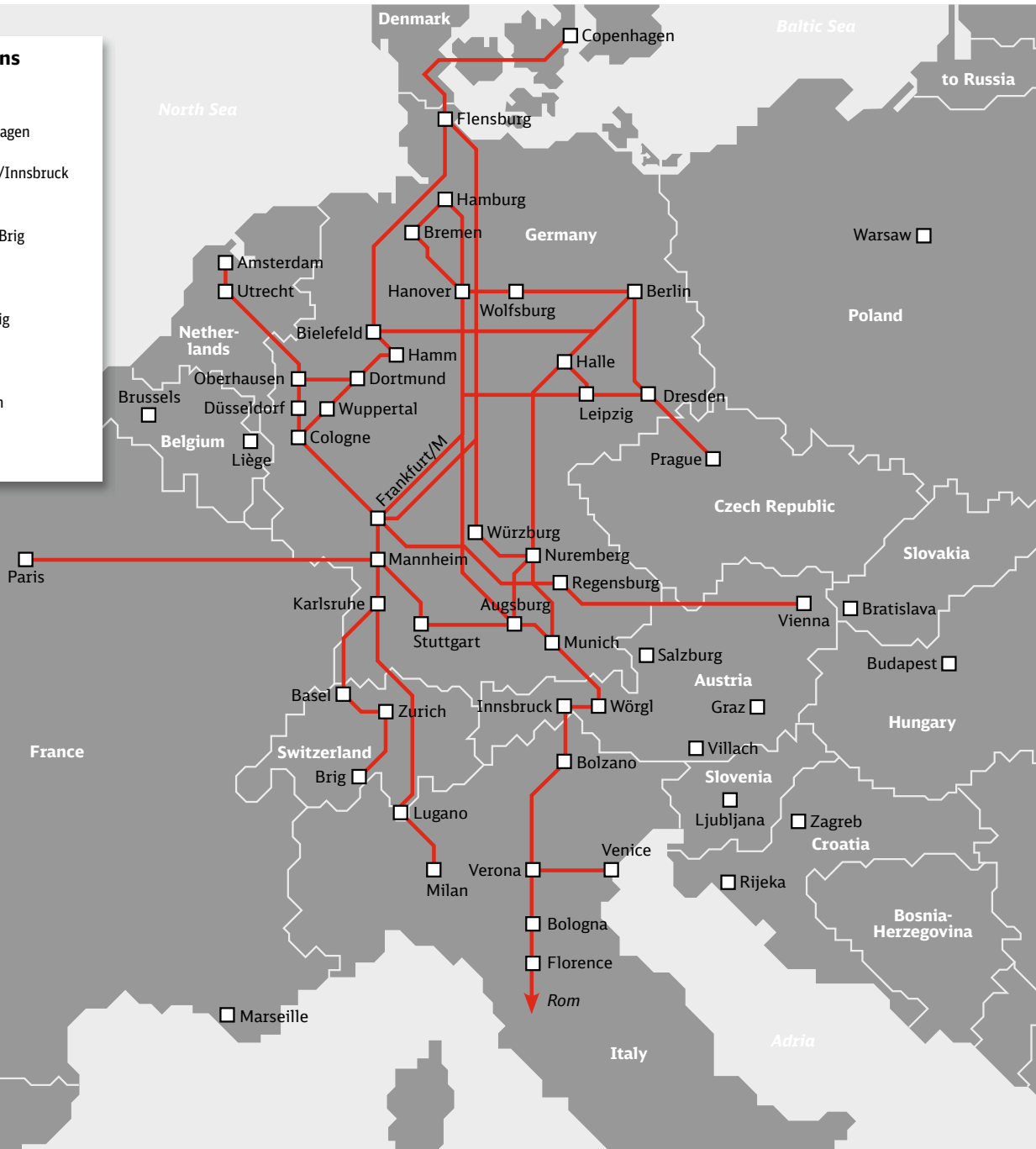

Information from A to Z – Answers to frequently asked questions about City Night Line

Air-conditioning and heating:

All City Night Line sleeping and couchette cars are air-conditioned. Active ventilation / heating ensures a pleasant temperature for passengers in seated cars.

Bicycle carriage:

City Night Line offers bicycle carriage on almost all lines. Bicycles are carried for a charge of EUR 10.00 (routes inside Germany EUR 9.00).

International bicycle tickets are accepted.

Advance reservations are compulsory and free of charge.

Further information is available in Germany from the cyclist hotline +49 (0) 1805 15 14 15 (EUR 0.14/min).

Booking period:

Booking supplements (reservation of the comfort category) for City Night Line trains can be made a maximum of 180 days in advance. If you book a ticket and supplement at the same time, this can be done 90 days in advance.

Shorter booking periods are possible for journeys prior to a change of timetable.

Bookings:

Bookings can be made at www.citynightline.net, at all DB Travel Centers, DB agencies and through the Deutsche Bahn service number +49 (0) 1805/996633 (14 ct/min for German landline calls, tariffs from foreign countries can deviate).

Payment for Internet and telephone bookings is by credit card or direct debit.

Other countries: Please contact a ticket outlet of the railway concerned.

Bookings for departures after 0.00 h:

Please check that all the data stated on your ticket is correct. If your train departs after 0.00 h, the date of departure is identical with the date of arrival.

Bulky luggage:

General luggage, skis, snowboards and toboggans can be carried free of charge on all lines. We recommend that you divide your luggage as follows: there is space in the compartment for your hand luggage, while larger items can be carried in the special luggage compartment. Please label all items of luggage with your home address and destination. For safety reasons, all winter sports equipment has to be carried in the luggage compartment.

A transport charge of EUR 15.00 / CHF 25.00 will be levied for each item of luggage which is not directly required for travel purposes (e.g. boxes, pictures, bulky musical instruments).

Check-in:

Your bed, couchette or seat will be kept free for you up to 15 minutes after the time of embarkation. You are therefore kindly requested to go to your berth as soon as the train departs. Once the crew member has clarified all the formalities with you there, you are free to move around the train and visit the bar or dining car.

Children:

Children aged up to 5 accompanied by a paying adult travel free of charge but are not entitled to a bed, couchette or seat of their own. Each bed or couchette may be used by a max. of 1 adult and 1 child. A separate bed, couchette or seat must always be booked for children aged 6 or over. Children have to have the appropriate ticket (e.g. child's ticket or accompany passenger's ticket) plus supplement or child's global fare. No child's discount is granted on supplements, as the discount has already been taken into account in the price of the child's ticket.

Compulsory reservations:

Reservations are compulsory for all comfort categories on City Night Line trains. Please note that a reservation for the City Night Line train does not entitle you to make a free seat reservation for any trains used before or after City Night Line.

Groups:

Reduced-rate tickets plus supplement or reduced-rate global fares can be booked for groups of 6 or more. Further information is available from all ticket outlets.

Internet bookings:

Full information about all City Night Line trains and how to book direct online is available on the Internet at www.citynightline.net, www.bahn.co.uk or www.bahn.ie

Luggage:

Each passenger is entitled to carry hand luggage plus one suitcase or travel holdall. Luggage can be stowed in the space under the beds, couchettes or seats and on the storage space in the compartment. A more convenient option is to have your luggage delivered to your destination by the courier luggage service (not available in all countries).

Passengers' rights:

The Deutsche Bahn passenger charter states standard, binding provisions governing passengers' rights in case of delays on long-distance and night train services. In contrast to daytime services, passengers' rights on City Night Line journeys only come into effect in case of delays of 120 minutes or more.

Payments on board:

In addition to cash payments in the currencies of the departure and destination countries, Euro/Mastercard, VISA and Diners are accepted.

Security on board:

All sleeping and couchette cars on night trains have special security facilities so that customers can lock the compartment from the inside. The crew will gladly show you how to use this equipment. City Night Line cannot assume any liability for passengers' luggage, clothing or personal belongings.

Smoking:

All City Night Line trains are non-smoking.

Through cars:

City Night Line trains frequently consist of several sections which are heading for different destinations. Please pay attention to the announcements and the coach position indicators on the platform. The service staff on the platform will be happy to help you. On some lines, the different train sections are rearranged in accordance with their destinations during the night. Please make sure that you and your luggage are in the right section of the train at that time. Do not hesitate to ask the train crew for assistance.

Ticket inspections:

If you are travelling in a sleeping or couchette car, the crew will be happy - if necessary - to take your ticket and, on international routes to most countries, your identification documents to avoid disturbing you during the night for ticket inspections and passport control. Your documents will be returned to you the next morning. Please check that the documents are returned to you in full.

Validity of supplements/global fares:

Supplements and global fares (combined ticket and supplement) are valid only on the date of travel stated, on the booked train and route. The relevant tickets are valid in accordance with the individual conditions. No compensation is available for lost tickets or supplements.
